


THE STORY OF PROPHET MUSA

Since that day, Allah sent more signs but Pharaoh refused to submit to Allah.



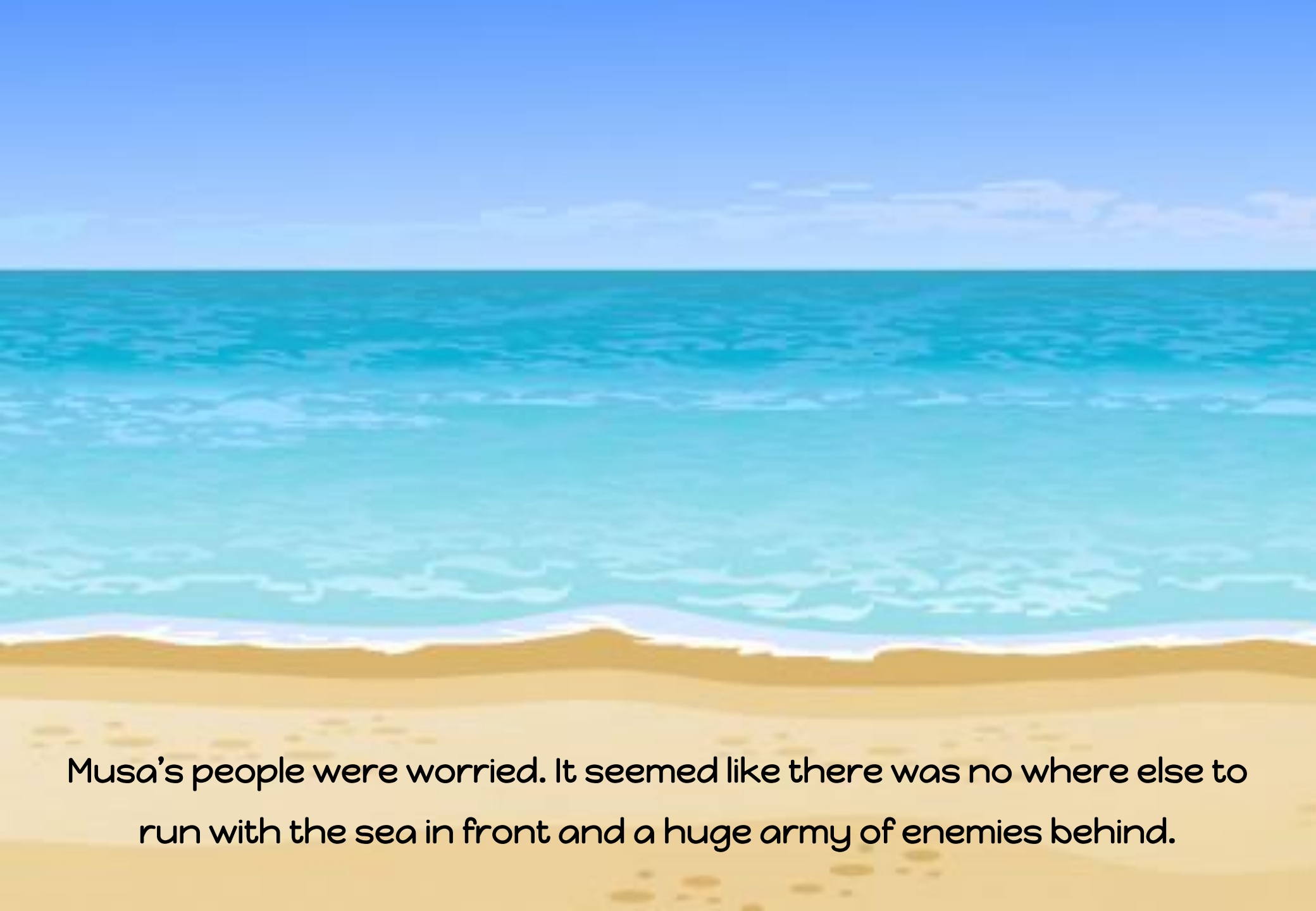
He tortured those who followed Musa in worshiping Allah alone.
